

EXPENSES FOR THE YEAR:

Here is a list of payments you can expect during a typical year:

1. Tuition due Bi-Monthly
2. Class attire including leotard, tights and shoes (all can be bought at Target, Wal-Mart and Payless Shoes)
3. Recital Costumes: \$50/\$60 per costume for most. Advance dancers; \$60.00/\$75.00 per costume \$50.00 deposit due by November 1st.
4. All Costume balances due by Jan 31st.
5. Recital tickets \$15.00 per ticket
6. Recital DVD \$40.00 (optional)
7. Recital pictures (Optional)
8. Competition fees are the responsibility of the dancer. That includes, entrance fees, make-up, travel, instruction ect. Competition fees must be paid by Oct. 31st. (For those in the competition team).

Lesson Payments

There is a non-refundable costume deposit of **\$50.00 per class**, due with the Nov. 1st payment; the final balance is due by Jan. 31st.

NOTE: Most cases ballet/tap 1, 2, 3/4, 5/6 and Creative Movement is a two in one costume requiring one \$50.00 deposit for both.

CANCELLATIONS:

In case of bad weather, we will follow the lead of the Mendon/Upton Schools. When school is cancelled, the studio will be closed, if there is a delayed opening, the morning classes will be cancelled. When there is an early release, the studio will be closed. The studio will leave a message on the machine and emails will be sent.

DWA does not cancel classes for early or full school release days due to teacher conferences etc. Credit is not given for missed classes.

Attire-Hair-Shoes

Creative Movement: Any of the little dance outfits that you find in stores are fine and tights. Whatever makes your child want to dance!! Pink ballet shoes & black tap shoes required.

Pre-Ballet to Advance Ballet: Leotard, dance shorts or skirts, tights. Pink Ballet shoes required. Hair pulled off neck. – NO Big Baggy T-shirts or sweat pants.

Acrobatics: Leotard or unitard, hair pulled back, barefoot.

Pre Hop/ Hip Hop: All dance wear allowed and sneakers. Advance levels, check with teacher. NO street clothes.

Tap/Jazz: Leotard, tights or form fitting tops/pants. Hair pulled back –black tap shoes, sun tan Jazz shoes.

Lyrical/Modern: Leotard, tights or form fitting tops/pants. Hair pulled back – Lyrical shoes or bare feet, teacher to advise.

Musical Theater: Tap, Jazz or Lyrical attire is acceptable. Hair pulled back. Shoes – check with teacher.

Please write your name in all your shoes!!!

NOTE: Only water is to be brought into the studio rooms. Food is allowed in the kitchen area and waiting room only.
